Unfinished Business

1. Public versus Private Roads
 - Access to private roads plowed or maintained by the Town.
 - Paul gave example of using Blue Heron Road and Youngs Crossing for bikes or pedestrians instead of the very steep end of Berwick Road.
 - Check with Town Manager on this subject.
2. MDOT Village Partnership Initiative (VPI)
 - Town Manager has been meeting with Maine DOT Regional Planner Stephen Cole on scope. Update from Town Manager in May.
3. Slowing Down Motor Vehicle Traffic
 - Focus on the first priority to reduce the speed on North Village Road to 25 mph.
4. League of American Bicyclists – Bike Friendly Community Application
 - Bruce and John M. to assist with preparation of application.
5. Speed of eBikes and Micro Mobility Vehicles in Bike Lanes and Sidewalks
 - Foreign worker education. Ramsey volunteered to speak to Alice Pearce about showing Bicycle Coalition of Maine bike safety video at any orientation that takes place.

6. OPD Distribution of Bike Lights and Reflective Bands

- Chief Lizanecz that the Police Association purchased \$1,500 worth of bike and backpack lights and has distributed nearly all of them thanks to Social Media awareness.
