Unfinished Business

1. Obed’s Lane Concern

- Pedestrian safety concern on busy cut-through street with no sidewalk. Obed’s Lane narrows and has limited line-of-sight visibility with a curve and hill at Main Street making for a dangerous situation.
- Tom Torno is adding to his proposed FY’24 budget (budget year beginning July 1, 2023) funding to construct a sidewalk on the north side of Obed’s Lane on the Town owned property, and for a sidewalk on Berwick Road from South Street to Spring Hill Road. Funding would need to be approved in the June 2023 warrant before construction could begin.
- Possible Federal funding for Bike/Ped projects including sidewalks. Check out:

- Chief Lizanecz will look at the possibility of additional signage to warn vehicles that pedestrians may be in the road.
- Chief Lizanecz to contact Jim Tassé of the Bicycle Coalition of Maine to see if there is an “Imagine People Here” project that could help.

2. Speed of Wheeled Vehicles in Bike Lanes and Sidewalks
 - eBikes, electric Scooters, Onewheels, electric skate boards, hoverboards.
 - Charley asked Chief Lizanecz to check with other towns as he meets with other Chiefs of Police on how they are addressing this issue.
 - Foreign worker education. Should connect with Chamber to see what is planned for 2023.
3. MDOT Village Partnership Initiative (VPI)
 - Use of ARPA funds for initiative were approved by the Select Board last June.
 - Need to draft project overview to review with Town Manager.
 - Need to engage Steve Cole, Regional Planner, Maine DOT with project overview.
4. New RRFB on Main Street at Panache -- Tracking
 - Bike Maine researched subject with Maine DOT and is still waiting for parts.
5. LED Lighting - Tracking
 - Installation of LED streetlights on Main Street should now be complete. Need to check previously defined crosswalks.
